Personal Statement

I hold to the position that the OCA's pension plan is substantially degraded financially and that mandated participation by OCA clergy and staff in the plan is therefore morally problematic. I also believe that honestly communicating the poor state of the plan to all plan stakeholders is the only appropriate first step towards a renewal of the plan's health and trustworthiness.

Should I be elected to the pension board I would advocate for significant policy and structural changes to the plan and a particular movement away from past precedents of over-emphasizing the wants and preferences of current pensioners (especially when these cause harm to the plan itself). The OCA's pension plan can reach an acceptable state of health longterm but only by systemic change and a thorough, ongoing commitment to financial transparency.
